

Putting on (donning) personal protective equipment (PPE)

Use safe work practices to protect yourself and limit the spread of infection


- keep hands away from face and PPE being worn
- change gloves when torn or heavily contaminated
- limit surfaces touched in the patient environment
- · regularly perform hand hygiene
- always clean hands after removing gloves

Pre-donning instructions

- ensure healthcare worker hydrated
- tie hair back
- remove jewellery
- check PPE in the correct size is available

Perform hand hygiene before putting on PPE



Apron


Pull over head and fasten at back of waist.





Surgical mask


Secure ties or elastic bands at middleof head and neck. Fit flexible band to nose bridge. Fit snug to face and below chin.



Eye Protection (Goggles/Face Shield)

If risk of splash injury

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Gloves

Select according to hand size. Extend to cover wrist.
