

To be used to identify patients within a care home who may be most at risk of harm or hospital admission as a result of their medications:

Care Home Questions

(To be used by the Pharmacy Team during conversations with care homes directly, perhaps as part of a weekly call to the care homes.)

- Are there any patients that you are concerned about within your home with regards to medicines (identify patients)?
- Have any patients had falls this week (identify patients)?
- Have any patients been more confused, dizzy, drowsy or displaying unusual symptoms including GI symptoms (identify patients)?
- Have any patients presented with swallowing difficulties for the first time (identify patients)?
- Have any patients presented with a sharp reduction in food or water intake (identify patients)?
