Cardiology Clinic Guide

LEAN: General Cardiology Clinic – patients are triaged by consultant as routine or urgent

CAAC: In-house clinic used to avoid ED/AMU admissions by offering stable patients a next day outpatient appointment

FACPC: Formally Rapid Access Clinic – patients are referred for appointment within 2 weeks for management of suspected stable angina
