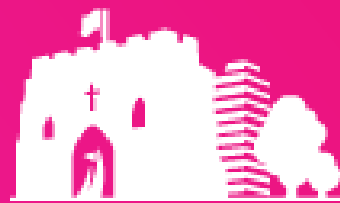

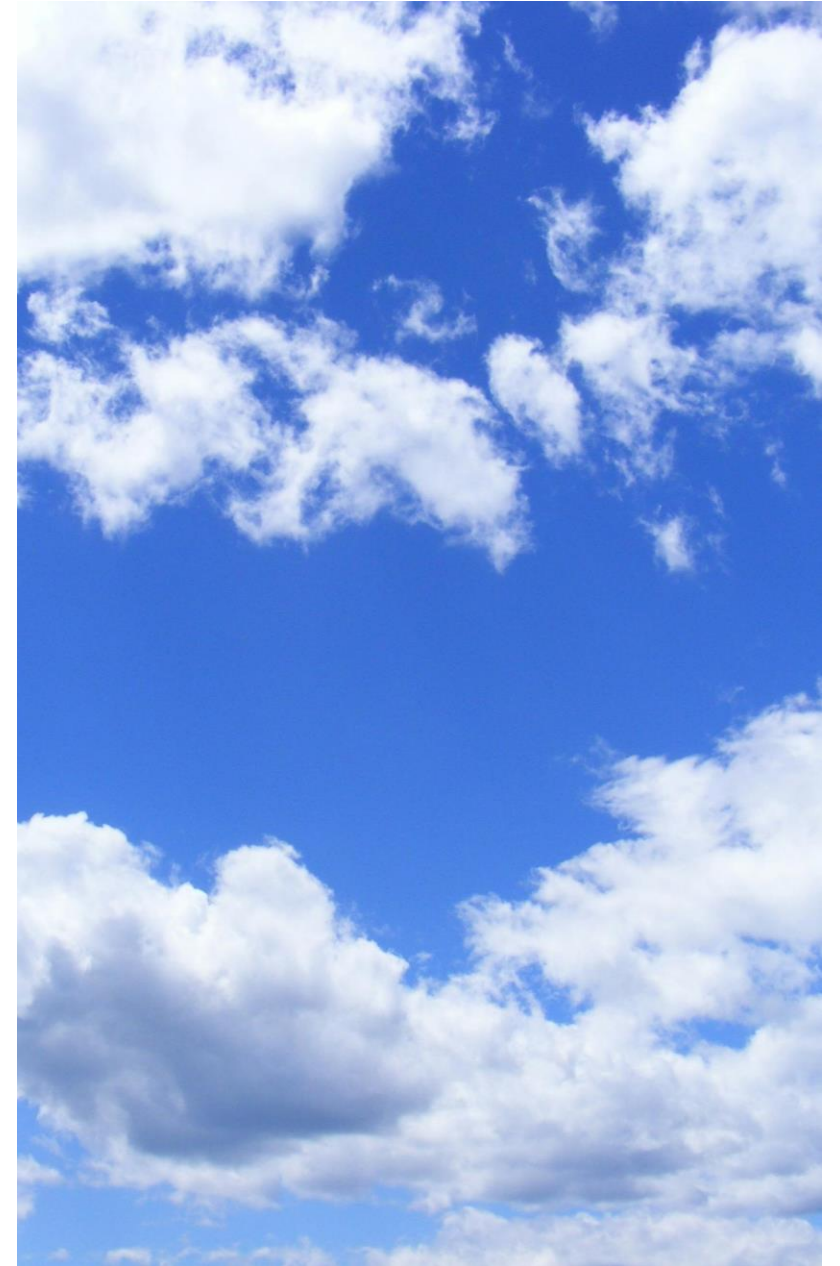

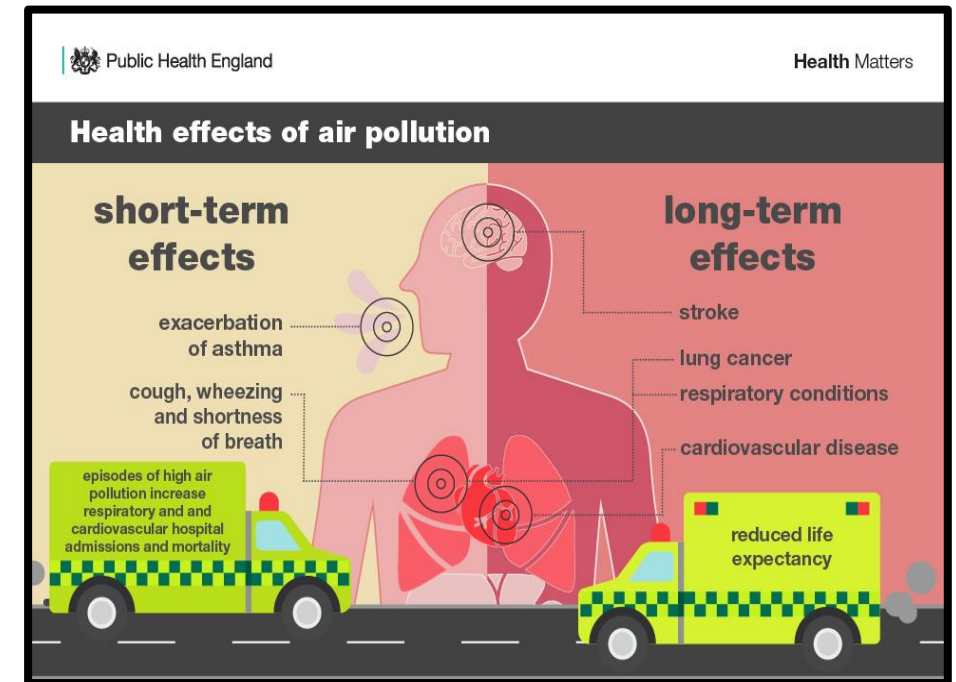
The project

21st century air pollution – “the invisible killer”

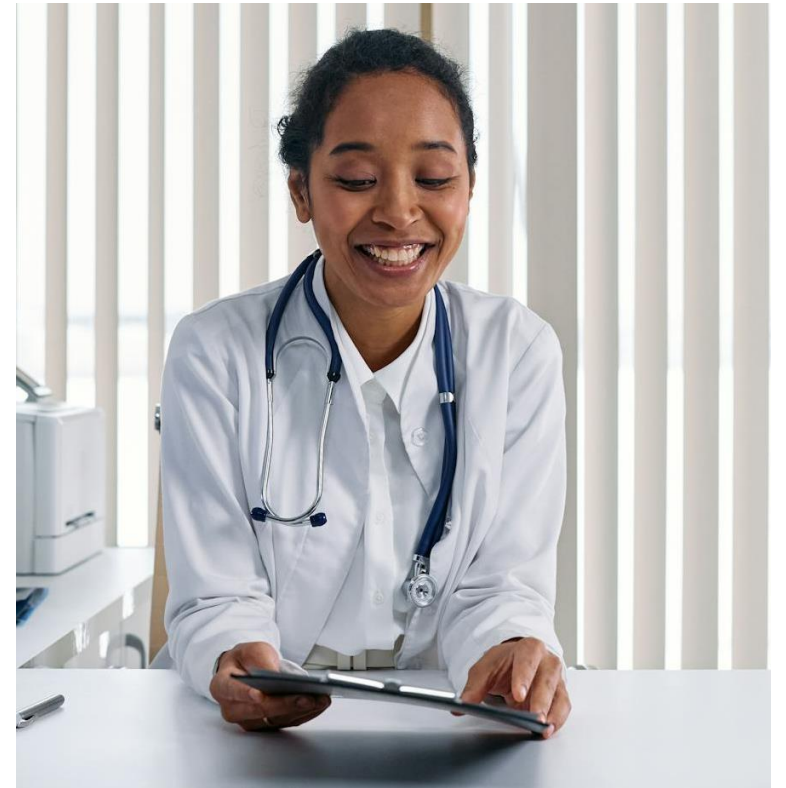
- In the UK, air pollution is the largest environmental risk to public health

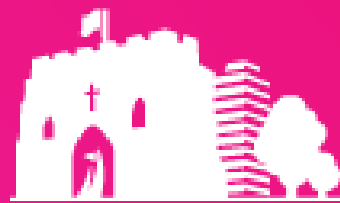
