Primary Medical Care (PMC) Teaching Opportunities Year 2024 -2025

BM6 Y0

- Opportunity for students to observe consultations in primary care
- Students are in their first year of study on the six year medical degree designed to widen participation in medicine.
- Students will have met additional contextual admissions criteria such as being a first generation applicant to Higher Education or being resident in an area with a postcode which falls within the lowest 20% of the Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD).
- 11 days over the course of the year either a Monday or Wednesday, half days could also be supported.
- Payment of **£500 per student** (subject to tariff confirmation)

Medicine in Practice 1 (MiP1)

- MiP1 takes place in the first year of the 5-year undergraduate entry programme.
- 11 sessions at a GP practice in small groups of 5-7
- Alternate Thursday afternoons. You could have 1 group or 2 groups (every Thursday)
- Two related staff development training sessions.
- Payment is £7710.00(subject to tariff confirmation) for 2 groups plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.
- Payment is £4080.00(subject to tariff confirmation) for 1 group plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.

Medicine in Practice 2 (MiP2)

- MiP2 takes place in the second year of the 5-year undergraduate entry programme.
- 6, 12 or 18 sessions in practice and 2 OSCEs in small groups of 5-7.
- Each group/s comes on a different Monday afternoon. This is dependent on taking 1, 2 or all 3 groups.
- One-two related staff development training sessions.
- Payment is £7050(subject to tariff confirmation) for 3 groups plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.
- Payment is £5070(subject to tariff confirmation) for 2 groups plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.
- Payment is £3090(subject to tariff confirmation) for 1 group plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.

BM4 Year 1 PMC

- BM4 Year 1 is the first year of the 4-year graduate entry programme.
- 11 sessions at GP practices in small groups of 4-5
- Alternate Thursday afternoons. You could take two groups (22 sessions) and teach every week during term time. Each group of students also completing 2-3 virtual SIM patient OSCE practise sessions, facilitated by their GP teacher.
- Payment is £7260(subject to tariff confirmation) for 2 groups, plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.
- Payment is £3885(subject to tariff confirmation) for 1 group, plus equipment and simulated patient allowance. BM4 Year 2 PMC Semester 1

- BM4 Year 2 is the second year of the 4-year graduate entry programme.
- 6 sessions at a GP practice in small groups of 4-5
- Alternate Thursday afternoons 2-5pm. You could take two groups (11 sessions) and teach every Thursday during Semester 1.
- Payment is £3840(subject to tariff confirmation) for Semester 1, 2 groups plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.
- Payment is £2175(subject to tariff confirmation) for Semester 1, 1 group plus equipment and simulated patient allowance.

BM4 Year 2 Semester 2

- Practices usually take individual students, though it may be possible to place some as pairs in larger surgeries.
- The PMC course encourages students to develop a holistic approach to patients and their care.
- 3 Rotations of 6 weeks placements January – June (3.5 days per week Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday morning).
- Payment of **£100 per session ~£4100 per student** (subject to tariff confirmation)

BM5 Year 3

- We would like practices preferably to take **pairs** of students to aid some joint teaching and visiting
- The Primary Medical Care & Long-Term conditions (LTCs) course encourages them to learn a holistic approach to patients and their care.
- 3 Rotations of 7 weeks, placements January – June (3.5 days per week Monday, Tuesday, Thursday all day and Friday morning).
- Payment of **£100 per session ~£4500 per student** (subject to tariff confirmation)

Final Year

- Opportunity for students to build on the experiences in the earlier years to further develop their consultation skills and begin to formulate management plans in own supervised student surgeries
- 10 sessions per week in 3 weeks placements between August and December
- Payment of **£100 per session ~£3000 per student** (subject to tariff confirmation)

Year 2 seminars

- 6 seminars Monday afternoons at Highfield campus focus on examinations and 2 OSCEs.
- Payment **£2910**(subject to tariff confirmation)

Year 3 seminars

- 7 seminars on consecutive Wednesday mornings, virtual & face to face at Highfield campus.
- Payment **£2535**(subject to tariff confirmation)

Final Year seminars

- 3 seminars before or after of the 3wk placement looking at cases and prescribing.
- Payment **£1215**(subject to tariff confirmation)

BM4 Year 2 Semester 2

- 6 seminars on Thursday afternoons. Currently virtual but may also be held at Winchester Education Centre
- Preference to BM4 teachers of Semester 1
- Payment **£2205**(subject to tariff confirmation)
