Diabetes Care Processes



AIM:

This topic is designed to support health and social care staff to efficiently deliver 8 of the 9 diabetes care processes recommended by NICE. It focuses on:

- ✓ The diabetes care processes and why they are important.
- ✓ Accurately assessing body mass index (BMI), blood pressure (BP) and smoking status.
- ✓ Knowing how and why kidney function and cholesterol levels are tested.
- ✓ Being able to undertake foot checks and encouraging people to attend eye screening.
- ✓ Knowing when to refer people for further support based on the diabetes care processes.

Please note: Retinal screening is not covered in this topic as it needs to be done by appropriately trained staff with suitable retinal photography equipment.
