Introduction

Solent NHS Trust Specialist Stoma Care Service is commissioned to provide a community based service to patients within Southampton City CCG alongside patients within the south west region of West Hampshire CCG **excluding** Ringwood, Fordingbridge, North Eastleigh but **including** some areas formally covered by Test Valley PCT (Test Valley South, including Romsey Town, Eastleigh South, including Netley, Hamble, Hedge End, West End)

The aim of the stoma care formulary is to be a working document with input from Solent NHS trust stoma care team and medicines management teams. The formulary will continue to be reviewed on a yearly basis with the current and new products being evaluated in terms of clinical effectiveness and cost.

The purpose of the formulary is to provide a list of stoma care accessories which should be selected for approximately 90% of prescribing in this area. The list has been developed based on the current evidence available on stoma care accessory products. There may be occasion when a formulary item is not effective. Therefore a non-formulary item will be prescribed. It is strongly recommended that the stoma care team review patients on non-formulary products. 1) ADHESIVE DISCS/RINGS/PADS/PLASTERS

Product Type	Product Name	Order code	Pack Size	Drug Tariff	Comments
Flange extenders Hydrocolloid based flange extenders reduces the risk of the development of other peristomal skin problems. (Smith et al, 2007)	Salts Flange Extender	SPH1	1 pack = 30	£12.38	Rationale: to increase wear time in the ileostomy, urostomy or colostomy patient. Also protects edges of flange from disintergration which may occur in hot weather and swimming. Indications for use: may be considered if large area of appliance needs to be cut due to size of stoma, or uneven anatomy at edge of flange. May be particularly useful in the management of parastomal hernias. Amount needed for 1 months supply: maximum 3 flange extenders required for each appliance change = 3 packs. In some cases may be used singularly for a problematic area

Indications for use: If patient is unable to activate the spray bottle Amount per appliance change: 1 box per 30 bags or baseplates/flanges

3) APPLIANCE BELTS

Indications for use: may be considered as an addition to a convexity appliance to prevent leakage and excoriated skin for a number of reasons such as retraction, scarring, uneven anatomy, stenosis. Amount needed: 1 belt for first order, then 1 belt every 3 months (belts can be washed)

N.B the belts below are compatible with the coloplast mio convex appliance.

4) SUPPORT GARMENTS

N.B Stoma care review to include discussion regarding most appropriate garment. We recommend belts rather than underwear if a patient prefers underwear then we would still recommend 2 per year and the patient can purchase more if they require. Other types of belts or underwear that do not have the support required for preventing a hernia or supporting a hernia we recommend that the patient purchases supportive underwear from clothing retail shops or from specialist ostomy companies.

Definition

"A parastomal hernia is a bulging of peristomal skin which is caused by loops of bowel through the facia around the stoma and into the subcutaneous tissue". (Rolstad et al, 1996)

Incidence

Studies reveal an incidence of 20-50% (Thompson M.J, 2008) Treatment is based on management of problems or symptoms associated with a parastomal hernia rather than prevention. A study by Thompson (2008) has shown a significant reduction in the incidence of parastomal hernia by the implementation of a prevention program, which includes wearing a belt or girdle when lifting or heavy work, for at least 1 year following surgery. Risk factors include; co morbidities, BMI, age, smoking, manual work

6) Irrigation/wash-out appliances

N.B Irrigation is a technique of washing out the bowel in order to regulate bowel habit. It allows the patient to have a 'continent stoma' for long periods of 24-48 hours following the procedure allowing the patient to wear a descrete stoma cap over the stoma in between irrigation. It is offered to patients with an end permenant colostomy who are able to irrigate. Patients may opt to irrigate for psycological reasons to improve quality of life.

7) Skin fillers and protectives

Orobase paste adheres to mucus membranes and to raw weeping areas forming a protective layer which prevent further damage from urine and faecal contact, allowing healing to take place.

Protective powder can be used where recurrent leaks cause persistently sore skin. It is also useful in the management of patients with mucocutaneous separation. Amount needed for 1 months supply: 1 bottle – not usually for long term use.


