

Intermittent Self Catheterisation Formulary

- Intermittent Catheterisation (ISC) should be considered as first line and gold standard
- Patient's should be assessed individually to ensure the correct catheter type is prescribed
- These are single use only
- Usage depends on patient needs but should not exceed 6 per day
- Patient needs dexterity and cognitive ability
- Help to reduce catheter associated urinary tract infections (CAUTI)
